JUDGEMENT AND DECREE ESTABLISHING NEWSPAPER

AS ONE OF GENERAL CIRCULATION.

The INTERMOUNTAIN NEWS, by its editor, owner, publisher and printer, having filed herein on the 1st day of April, 1959, a verified petition to have its standing as a newspaper of general circulation ascertained and established according to law, and said petition coming on regularly for hearing in Department One of the above-entitled court, William H. Phelps appearing as attorney for petitioner and evidence having been introduced in support thereof;

It appearing and the Court finds that substance of said petition has been published in accordance with and pursuant to Section 6062 of the Government Code of the State of California and that the affidavits of publication on file in this matter set forth said publication and are true in all respects, proof of said publications of said petition being on file, and that said publications also included notice of the time and place when the petitioner intended to make application to the Court to have said petition heard and determined; that said publications

1 were made in the REDDING RECORD SEARCHLIGHT and the COURIER
2 FREE PRESS, a newspaper of general circulation published in
3 Shasta County, California and in the INTERMOUNTAIN NEWS, the
4 petitioning newspaper;

5 It further appearing that the Court fixed the 27th day of
6 April, 1959, at 1:30 O'clock P.M. in Department One thereof as
7 the time and place of such hearing and that at said hearing the
8 Court considered both oral and documentary evidence and finds
9 that all the allegations set forth in said petition are true in
10 every respect;

11 It further appearing and the Court hereby finds that the
12 INTERMOUNTAIN NEWS has been established, printed and published
13 weekly in the Town of Fall River Mills, County of Shasta, State
14 of California, for more than one year prior to April 1, 1959, the
15 date of filing said petition and specifically that it was so
16 established, printed and published continuously on each and every
17 week from March 20, 1958, to the date of the hearing in this mat-
18 ter; that it is a newspaper published for the dissemination of
19 local and telegraphic news and intelligence of a general charact-
20 er and has a bona fide subscription list of paying subscribers;
21 and the Court being fully advised in the premises,

22 NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED
23 that the INTERMOUNTAIN NEWS is hereby determined and declared to
24 be a newspaper of general circulation.
